Preliminary discussions for the organization of a <u>Latinoamerican</u> Association of Paleobotany and Palynology were held in Mexico City, December, 1972, during the First Latinoamerican Congress of Botany.. The stated objectives of this new Association will be:

- 1) To group all specialists doing research in paleobotany and palynology in Latin American countries.
- 2) To promote the exchange of information related to research and teaching of these fields in Latin America by means of a <u>Newsletter</u> and a publication including original research papers.
- 3) To promote sections in these fields within the framework of Latin American Congresses of Botany, Geology, and/or Paleontology, or to hold meetings exclusively on paleobotany and palynology.

As a result, Latin American researchers would have more opportunities through their Association to exchange information and materials with members of similar international organizations.
