

Author's Guide

Authors are required to make every effort to ensure that abstracts are presented clearly and concisely in order to make the best use of the available publication space.

Contributions must be the result of original work.

Abstracts must be prepared in Word using Times New Roman 12-point font.

The title must be concise and representative of the content of the article, written in uppercase (bold) and left-aligned.

Authors' names should appear in bold and lowercase.

Institutional affiliation/s and email address/es should be written in regular font.

The body text must be single-spaced, 400 words maximum, and consist of a single paragraph. Abstracts should contain the conclusions or results of the work carried out.

No illustrations, references, nomenclatural novelties or species authorships should be included.

Funding sources supporting the abstract may be indicated.

Abstracts may be submitted in Spanish, Portuguese, or English.
